A Functional Cognitive Stylistic Study of Online Horoscopes Predictions

Abstract

The present study mainly investigates the linguistic choices used in daily horoscope predictions that attract the attention of readers globally. It employs a functional cognitive stylistic approach to analyze the language of horoscopes, concentrating on how linguistic structures shape meaning and reader interpretation. The primary objectives are to explore how functional cognitive stylistics improves the understanding of language use in horoscopes. The study adopts a qualitative eclectic model that integrates functional cognitive stylistics to achieve these goals. It adopts the tools of functional stylistics, particularly textual metafunctions (Halliday & Matthiessen, 2014), Moreover, it applies Schema Theory to explore how readers' pre-existing knowledge impacts their understanding, and Figure-Ground Theory (Stockwell, 2020) examines the emphasis on specific elements to guide focus while textual metafunctions establish discourse by structuring information flow, enhancing readability, and supporting key ideas within the horoscope predictions. Daily horoscope predictions published on Vogue India's website is the target of the study. The findings show that horoscopes capture attention and support important concepts through vague but captivating language. The language of horoscopes contains crucial cues that activates readers' schema globally. The prominence of linguistic choices is meant to appeal to audience world wildly.

المستخلص:

تهتم هذه الدراسة بشكل رئيسي بالاخيارات اللغوية المستخدمة في تنبؤات الأبراج اليومية التي تجذب انتباه القراء عالميًا. وهي تستخدم نهجًا أسلوبيًا معرفيًا وظيفيًا لتحليل لغة الأبراج، مع التركيز على كيفية تشكيل البنى اللغوية للمعنى وتفسير القارئ. تتمثل الأهداف الرئيسية في استكشاف كيف تعمل الأسلوبية المعرفية الوظيفية على تحسين فهم استخدام اللغة في الأبراج. تعتمد الدراسة نموذجًا انتقائيًا نوعيًا يدمج الأسلوبية المعرفية الوظيفية لتحقيق هذه الأهداف. وهي تعتمد على أدوات الأسلوبية الوظيفية (Halliday & Mattheissen, 2014)

علاوة على ذلك، تطبق نظرية المخطط لاستكشاف كيفية تأثير المعرفة المسبقة للقراء على فهمهم، وتدرس نظرية الشكل والخلفية (Stockwell, 2020) التركيز على عناصر محددة لتوجيه التركيز بينما تؤسس الوظائف النصية الخطاب من خلال هيكلة تدفق المعلومات، وتحسين قابلية القراءة، ودعم الأفكار الرئيسية داخل تنبؤات الأبراج. تُركز الدراسة على توقعات الأبراج اليومية المنشورة على موقع مجلة فوغ الهندية. تُظهر النتائج أن الأبراج تجذب الانتباه وتدعم مفاهيم مهمة من خلال لغة مبهمة لكنها ملفتة. تحتوي لغة الأبراج على معلومات جوهرية تُنشّط مخطط القراء عالميًا. يُقصد بروز الخيارات اللغوية جذب جمهور واسع.

1. Introduction

Daily horoscope predictions offer personalized forecasts that provide insights into individuals' personalities and futures and engage them emotionally, nurturing self-reflection through the lens of astrology. Using stylistic devices such as metaphors and imagery plays a vital role in determining readers' interpretations and emotional responses. At the same time, linguistic techniques like modal verbs introduce ambiguity and adaptability, making predictions more applicable and open to interpretation (Allum, 2011). Beyond their stylistic appeal, horoscopes have a deep psychological impact, often influencing individuals' perceptions and behaviours through the expectation effect, where readers subconsciously align their actions with the predictions they encounter (He, 2011). Furthermore, horoscopes provide comfort and reassurance, mainly during periods of indecision, by offering guidance and a perceived sense of control over life events. They can also generate a sense of belonging, as individuals identify with their zodiac signs and feel associated with a larger group, reducing feelings of isolation. Additionally, astrology figures daily routines by influencing how individuals structure their time and approach responsibilities in accordance with their zodiac characters. However, this reliance on horoscopes may also lead to negative effects, such as increased dependency and worry, when predictions are perceived as unfavourable (Happifull, 2024). Given the important role of language in shaping these interpretations, this study aims to answer the following research questions:

- **1.** How does the functional cognitive stylistic approach deepen the understanding of language use in selected daily horoscopes?
- **2.** In what ways do the cognitive tools shape the interpretation of themes in daily horoscopes?

2. Literature Review

This section provides a summary of prior research that has examined the language of horoscopes using stylistics and other analytical frameworks. For example, Kučerová (2023) analyzed 432 weekly horoscopes from Astrology, Horoscope, and Teen Vogue over 12 weeks, focusing on the register, authorial style, and genre. By using a combination of qualitative and quantitative methods, the study applied Biber and Conrad's (2009) register analysis, Leech's (2007) authorial style framework, and Bhatia's (1993) genre analysis. The research concluded that online weekly horoscopes form a distinct genre with shared linguistic and rhetorical features, including frequent lexical items such as "energy, moon, Jupiter, and Venus" (Kučerová, 2023, p. 24). The study supported its findings with corpus analysis, emphasizing the consistent style across sources. Another

study by He (2011) who conducted a cross-linguistic and cultural analysis of horoscopes in English, Chinese, Japanese, and German, focusing on semantic and grammatical structures. The study looks at how different cultures shape horoscope discourse using qualitative and quantitative approaches. The findings revealed that Chinese horoscopes emphasized caution, while English promoted self-affirmation and agency. German and Japanese horoscopes were positioned between these two tendencies. The study highlighted how cultural differences influence horoscope rhetoric and meaning construction (He, 2011). From a different linguistic perspective, Koka et al. (2023) performed a discourse analysis of lexical bundles in English horoscopes using a 1.9-million-word dataset processed with AntConc. The research identified 980 distinct lexical bundles, primarily three-word and four-word sequences, contributing to fluency and coherence in horoscope texts. These lexical bundles were categorized structurally and functionally, revealing key themes such as guidance, relationships, and emotional reassurance. The study emphasized the importance of lexical bundles in shaping the discourse of horoscope identity and informal style (Koka et al., 2023).

These previous studies examined horoscopes by applying different linguistic approaches, each shed light on unique features of horoscope language. These studies are important, but there is no study that conducted an analysis of daily horoscopes using functional cognitive stylistics in the literature. This study aims to address this gap by discovering how linguistic features in horoscopes interact with reader expectations and experiences. By applying a functional cognitive stylistic approach, this research can show how language choices affect meaning and reader engagement.

3. Method and Data

This study employs a qualitative research methodology to investigate the language of selected daily horoscopes. The focus is on analyzing the linguistic patterns and themes in horoscopes. This functional stylistic approach allows for an in-depth examination of how horoscopes are crafted, engaging readers cognitively and emotionally. Cognitive stylistic theoretical framework includes Schema Theory and Figure-Ground Theory (Stockwell, 2020). Two main cognitive stylistic tools are employed in this study. Firstly, schema theory helps to understand how readers' prior knowledge impacts their interpretation of horoscopes. A schema is a cognitive framework or construction that arranges and stores knowledge in our minds, allowing readers to comprehend and navigate the world (Gibbons & Whiteley, 2018; Jaafar, 2020). Second, figure-ground theory enables to examine how certain elements are emphasized or de-emphasized to guide readers' focus, while textual metafunctions organize discourse by structuring information flow,


enhancing readability, and emphasizing main ideas within the horoscope predictions (Stockwell, 2020). Stockwell (2020, p.25) states these specific elements, "attractors" within a text, capture the reader's attention (see **Figure 1).** There are many types of attractors, which include:

- 1. Newness: Elements that are presented or highlighted during reading. For example, "surly sullen bell" in line 2 from (Shakespeare's Sonnet 71). The bell brings additional and dramatized focus toward the perceptual field of the reader. This "bell" is most likely the first thing that captures attention as it is personified, being "surly" and "sullen", which makes it a lot more attractive and emotionally charged than a mere object (Stockwell, 2020, p. 81).
- 2. Agency: Attention is more drawn to active than passive verbs.
- 3. Topicality: Subjects inside an expression are more eye-catching than objects. For example, "The man shot the boy". The man is the (subject) and attracts more attention due to his position in the sentence. The boy is the (object) and serves as the background (Gibbons & Whiteley, 2018, p.153).
- 4. Activeness: Verbs with strong actions or reactions tend to attract attention. For example, "the bell Give warning to the world" and "Nay, if you read this line, remember not the hand that writ it, for I love you so." These lines display a progression from action to passivity. The writer takes active roles while the addressee is progressively passive, such as the writer is shown as active: "the bell giving warning," "the hand that writes," In contrast, the addressee is mostly a recipient of actions, apparent in imperative forms (Stockwell, 2020, p. 82).

The functional stylistics level adopts Halliday and Matthiessen (2014) model to analyze the data and explore how language functions within texts. This study focuses on the textual meta-function which organizes a message within a text. It is typically concerned with the "internal architecture" of a text, ensuring that language is coherent, flowing, and relevant to the preceding and following text. According to Halliday and Matthiessen (2014), language describes facts and connects different parts of discourse, making the text unified and meaningful within its context. This function determines how information is arranged to create a clear, structured narrative. Theme and rheme are two key aspects of the message in the textual meta- function. The theme is the starting point, while the rheme provides new information. The theme is the "point of departure" that links the clause to what has come before, and the rheme develops this starting point with new information. According to Halliday, the theme appears at the beginning of the clause, and the rheme is the development of the theme (Halliday & Matthiessen, 2014).

The data of this study include the twelve daily horoscope predictions published on Vogue India's website in the first of January 2025 (Sahgal, 2025). Some basic criteria orienting data selection as follows: The selected horoscopes should be written in authentic English to convey authenticity and evoke readers' emotions. The horoscopes should represent common themes found in astrological predictions, such as advice related to relationships, finances, or personal growth.

4. Data Analysis and Results

This section offers a comprehensive analysis of horoscope texts by applying functional cognitive stylistic framework. It focuses on daily horoscopes published on the Vogue India website, particularly on the first of January 2025 for all horoscopes. It investigates how the linguistic features of these texts form meaning, engage readers, and influence their interpretations. The data is analysed according to two levels: the first level is the cognitive stylistic level which focuses on schema and figure and ground. The second level focuses on the functional stylistic tools.

1. Aries Horoscope: January 1, 2025

"Take a moment to reflect on where you want your relationships to be headed this year, Aries. If you have been playing subservient - why! If you have been rushing through them - why? This year is about to teach you a thing or two about nurturing yourself, your plants and your closest ones.

Work like a team and make it happen". (Sahgal, 2025)

4.1 First level of analysis: cognitive stylistics

Schema Theory

The description of Aries horoscope shows a preserving schema that helps readers integrate new ideas without radically altering their worldview. By offering constructive solutions, such as "Work collaboratively and make it happen," the horoscope admits previous disruption. However, it comforts readers that relationships can be improved through effort, reshaping rather than rejecting their beliefs. However, a reinforcing schema strengthens readers' existing beliefs and expectations, as seen in a horoscope that highlights self-reflection and personal growth, which are common themes in astrology that many expect. For instance, "This year is about to teach you a thing or two about nurturing yourself, your plants and your closest ones " reinforces the significance of emotional connections, validating readers who already worth self-improvement. In contrast, a disrupting schema challenges assumptions, prompting readers to rethink their perspectives.

Moreover, different stylistic strategies are employed in the lines to promote a motivational mood. For example, direct instructions are given to the audience by using imperative sentences like: "take a moment to reflect," and "work like a team and make it happen." These sentences encourage self-reflection and action. The rhetorical question, "If you have been playing subservient—why! If you have been rushing through them—why?" asks everyone to think critically while emphasizing that something needs to change. Metaphors used in "nurturing yourself, your plants, and your closest ones," equate relationships and self-care to growth while bringing to attention the need for emotional investment. Moreover, time is embodied as exercising an active power over personal development in the statement, "this year is about to teach you a thing or two," which ascribes an element of personification to the words.

• Figure and Ground

In terms of figure and ground, the extract introduces the concept of newness through its call for reflection and growth. The focus on nurturing relationships and self suggests a fresh perspective on personal development. Aries prediction text showcases agency effectively; by directly questioning the reader's behaviors, it empowers them to take charge of their relational dynamics. This active voice fosters a sense of responsibility and encourages proactive involvement in both self-care and mutual care within relationships. Moreover, the themes of topicality and activeness are prominent. Relationships, a universally relatable topic, are presented in a way that emphasizes their dynamic nature. The directive to "work like a

team" underscores the importance of active participation, moving away from mere passive existence in relationships.

2. Second level of analysis: Functional Stylistics

From a functional stylistics perspective, the textual metafunction of the Aries horoscope prediction is skillfully employed; theme serves as the departure point of a clause, which establishes the focus, whereas the rheme provides adding new or contrastive information about it. For example, in the sentence "Take a moment to reflect on where vou want vour relationships to be headed this year, Aries." The theme does set the idea of self-reflection primary. At the same time, the theme adds a counter notion, which is self-contradiction in this case. In the same sense, predictive phrases like "It's time for the year to teach you a thing or two about nurturing yourself, your plants and your closest ones...," come with the command, "Work like a team and make it happen," move from a statement to an order which confirms collaboration and doing. The vocative function in this horoscope is directly addressed to "Aries." This serves the purpose of engaging the audience. Other stylistic strategies are achieved primarily through reference and lexical cohesion. For example, the repetition of the words "relationships," closest ones," and "team." which all relate to ideas of connecting and collaborating. Similarly, "nurturing" and "work like a team" point to efforts intertwined with care. Reference cohesion is done through markers such as "this year," which places the reader in a particular period, and the second person, "you," which allows for direct contribution. In addition, the horoscope is coherent because there is a balance between given and new information. "If vou have been playing subservient why!" proposes that some information is expected to be known by the reader regarding their past relationships, whereas "This year is about to teach you a thing or two about nurturing yourself" gives hints for the future.

2. Taurus Horoscope: January 1, 2025

"Your life is about to pick pace, shift gears and all that time you've invested in waiting along the bylanes is about to reap you rewards. Taurus, allow yourself to keep trusting your intuition, let your fears take a back seat as your Angels and guides gently nudge you forward, towards all that you deserve. It is not just the first day of a new year; it is the beginning of a new chapter for you". (Sahgal, 2025)

First level of analysis: Cognitive Stylistics Schema Theory

In this horoscope, a preserving schema shows that the ideas here are consistent with sociocultural and psychological perceptions regarding beginnings, luck, and guidance. Irrational belief regarding horoscopes is respected for their norms in providing suggestive statements designed to comfort and predict results. With concepts such as waiting and reward in combination, the idea of a direct connection between patience and success is common, thus allowing for easy understanding by readers? While reinforcing Schema, the beliefs in intuition, fate, luck, and even Spirit are reinforced through the text, emphasizing one's trusting journey towards one's goals. It also seeks to ensure the reader embraces these concepts to foster positivity. Angels and spiritual guides describe how "vour guides gently nudge you forward," which supports the idea of spiritual help, reinforcing the claims further. In contrast to disrupting Schema, the idea of 'passive' waiting is challenged by requesting to "allow yourself to keep trusting your intuition." Contrary to many readers ' beliefs, this emphasizes action, movement, or progress instead of waiting. Those doubtful of astrology or any form of spiritual guidance may have their preconceived thoughts disrupted when they encounter the phrase 'Angels and guides'.

Figure and Ground

Regarding figure and ground, the text focuses on how some parts are highlighted, and others relate to the context. The idea of newness is evident with phrases such as "beginning of a new chapter" and "first day of a new vear," which portray change and new beginnings as salient Figures. The agency is foregrounded with Taurus; allow yourself to trust your intuition, which suggests active participation in future-shaping while guides gently nudge you forward to extract external agency. Topicality is visible within those who need reassurance about changes framing self-metamorphosis and foreordained as pivotal thematic figures. Expressions such as "is about to," "it is the beginning," and "all that you deserve" render the expressions more definitive and more definite concerning change. More so, activeness in the extract is depicted by verbs of action, "pick pace," "shift gears," "allow," "trust," and "nudge forward," all of which suggest movement and development. Finally, the text achieves fullness by presenting a complete and structured message, including an initial state, a transition, and a predicted outcome, in this manner fostering a sense of fulfilment and finality.

2. Second level of analysis: Functional Stylistics

The text mainly employs thematic patterns, particularly through imperative structures such as "allow yourself" and "let your fears take a back seat," which contribute to a motivational and engaging rhetorical style. The theme-rheme progression simplifies logical flow, as seen in clauses like "Your life is about to pick pace, shift gears," where "Your life"

functions as the theme, while the rheme introduces new information about forthcoming change. Cohesion is preserved through lexical repetition, such as "**trust,**" "**intuition,**" and "**fear,**" reinforcing the motivational message, along with the use of personal pronouns, which create direct engagement with the reader. Additionally, conjunctive devices like "and" and "as" create logical connections between ideas, ensuring textual fluidity.

The passage also demonstrates a clear progression from predictive statements about future transformation to imperative encouragement, guiding the reader from expectation to action. Thus, the text effectively utilizes the textual metafunction to structure meaning coherently and persuasively, reinforcing its rousing intent. The given text employs several stylistic devices to motivate and inspire the readers. The most striking one is a metaphor, such as "pick pace, shift gears," which likens the progression of life to driving, which reflects motion and change. In the same way, "waiting along the bylanes" serves as a metaphor for being patient and waiting for success. Another important device is personification, as in "let your fears take a back seat," which gives the emotion of fear human characteristics and, in this way, indicates a person's ability to manage their feelings

3. Gemini Horoscope: January 1, 2025

Hidden in the dragon's lair lies your treasure, but this is not just any dragon, Gemini. It is your personal dragon that is safeguarding your relationships, your dreams and hopes and so much more. Sure you may feel like you are off to a rocky start today, but the cosmos wants to remind you that as you take one step at a time, the path ahead will be revealed to you. (Sahgal, 2025)

1. First level of analysis

• Cognitive stylistics: Schema Theory

In terms of preserving schema, this horoscope caters to the most important astrological types, which include self-development, challenges, and guidance, which are revealing. "The cosmos wants to remind you," for instance, supports the belief that makes the reader reinforce an idea or schema already created. If the audience already subscribes to the belief system of astrology, an ideal schema will be in place. Furthermore, in reinforcing schema, the metaphor of a 'personal dragon' guarding relationships dreams and strengthens the idea that internal challenges are meaningful and protective. The model proposes that difficulties serve a greater purpose, which can include one's self-development. Paraphrasing the saying and substituting more mainstream concepts like the 'personal dragon' on particular scenarios makes the reader's worldview valid. The horoscope is constructed around an extended metaphor, where the "dragon's lair" represents personal challenges, and the "treasure" symbolizes relationships, ambitions, and aspirations, adding depth and intrigue. Personification is employed to endow the cosmos with human attributes, as in "the cosmos wants to remind you," portraying the universe as a guiding force that reinforces a sense of destiny or fate. Vivid imagery enhances this effect, with phrases like "hidden in the dragon's lair lies your treasure," evoking a mysterious, mythical setting, and "the path ahead will be revealed to you," suggesting a journey of discovery and progression. However, according to disrupting schema, this metaphor could significantly alter their schema, specifically those with a predisposed notion regarding dragons and astrology. The idea that a hidden treasure, which in this case refers to relationships and goals, is well protected opposes the belief that struggles are meaningless. Cognitive restructuring is the possible outcome of such a scheme disruption. It can make people question or change their beliefs; symbolism further enriches the horoscope, with the dragon acting as a guardian of difficulties, the treasure demonstrating valuable but difficultto-attain goals, and the path symbolizing personal development and the unfolding of fate.

• Cognitive stylistics: Figure and Ground

This horoscope describes a strong figure-ground dynamic with the metaphor "dragon's lair," symbolizing hidden relationships, treasures, dreams, and hopes. This type of imagery presents newness and makes the message feel fresh and unexpected at the same time. Different forces share agency where the dragon serves as a protector, the reader takes an active role, and the cosmos exists as a guiding force. This type of metaphor is topical and resonates with the endeavors of those in dire need of guidance for the New Year. Its definiteness counters straightforward advice "take one step at a time" alongside metaphors that enjoyment creativity. The message is also active as it prompts action and motivation by stating that "the path ahead" will reveal itself in due course. Finally, the description is increased by divine help and ritual depth, which increases one's certainty of directly engaging with the enriching and deepening meaning of the message when confronted with problems.

2. Second level of analysis: Functional Stylistics

In this horoscope the thematic element, which establishes the basis of the message, is conveyed through the mysterious statement, "Hidden in the dragon's lair lies your treasure, but this is not just any dragon, Gemini." setting a magical and symbolic tone. The rhematic component introduces new information and explicates the dragon's metaphorical representation of personal aspects such as relationships, dreams, and hopes, reinforcing their defending and guiding nature. The vocative function is existing in the direct address, "Gemini." It serves to participate or call attention to the reader,

who is apparently a Gemini. The vocative personalizes the horoscope, making it feel more direct and close. Cohesion is achieved through lexical repetition and logical connectors like "but" and "sure," which maintain ideas' flow and contrastive progression. The information structure is organized to progressively engage the reader, starting with a mysterious statement, clarifying its figurative meaning, and concluding with a comforting message about gradual revelation. This structural arrangement aligns with the horoscope's purpose of providing guidance and encouragement, rendering the message coherent and meaningful. In addition, the phrase "your treasure" or "your dragon" makes the text even more relatable to Gemini, as using pronouns achieves a personal connection to the audience. Logical connectors like 'but,' 'as,' and 'that,' act as a tent to the fragmentary words tied in dissonance, allowing readers to flow from the discomfort of starting "the rocky start" to the comfort of being "the revealing o

4. Cancer Horoscope: January 1, 2025

"You've got your pot of gold, Cancer, and on the surface it all feels perfect, then why are you still waiting in despair for your day to arrive. Look where you are - not only have you been waiting to get here, but also isn't it exactly what your dreams were made of? Make mindful choices that help you balance your personal, professional and social goals. For you community trumps everything else, so build your life with this renewed focus". (Sahgal, 2025)

1. First level of analysis

• cognitive stylistics: Schema Theory

According to preserving schema, the horoscope acknowledges potential disappointment: "why are you still waiting in despair?" but eventually redirects the focus toward careful choices and balance to sustain contentment. This preserves the idea that Cancer individuals can find happiness through self-reflection and social harmony, adapting their goals without forsaking their core values. While reinforcing schema, this extract enhances the notion that Cancer individuals value community and life balance. The way encourages them to appreciate their endeavors and prioritize social interactions aligns with the common belief that Cancer is a nurturing, emotionally motivated sign. The phrase "For you, community trumps everything else" supports this idea, reinforcing the schema that Cancers flourish in collective, emotionally supportive environments.

In contrast, disrupting schema challenges prior beliefs and forces a review of one's viewpoint. In this case, the horoscope disrupts the expectation that reaching success automatically leads to contentment. The line "then why are you still waiting in despair for your day to arrive?" proposes that

inner satisfaction may still be lacking despite external accomplishments. This disrupts the assumption that external achievements alone bring happiness, motivation, contemplation, and a mind shift. While these figure attractors stand out, fullness acts as a ground attractor by allowing room for personal interpretation, rendering the message universally relatable. These attractors shape the horoscope's persuasive and empowering tone, with the agency being the dominant force driving the message.

1. Second level of analysis: functional stylistics

In terms of functional stylistics perspective, the theme and rheme structure are exemplified in the phrase, "You are leaving a part of your heartache behind and slamming the door shut for good, Capricorn" In this expression, "You" is the theme that places a Capricorn in the centre, while the rheme "leaving a part of your heartache behind" gives information about the change. The expression "Capricorn" is a vocative reference assigned to the reader whose zodiac sign is Capricorn. The Vocative Case emphasizes giving more personal focus to the message, capturing the reader's attention and making the guidance more pertinent. This use of direct address aids in bridging the gap with the audience, personalizing the horoscope to the reader's expectations. Cohesion is created by the repeated concepts of change of state and action like "reassessing and reevaluating." Conjunctive cohesion is seen in the sentence, "Whatever part of your life you may have romanticized, you are reassessing and reevaluating," in which "whatever" links previously held notions to the present ones. Lastly, reference cohesion is illustrated by pronouns such as "this" and "this is not your year of excess and resilience," which goes back to the prominent idea of change. All these elements combine to create a well-integrated text that motivates the audience, which is the main purpose of the horoscope

11. Aquarius Horoscope: January 1, 2025

"Wanting to create something big but feeling unsure and doubtful, Aquarius? Well, it is only in your crumbling tower moments that you realise how good you are at parkour or even levitating, whatever floats your boat. 1. First level of analysis

• Cognitive stylistics: Schema Theory

Regarding schema theory, Aquarius horoscope message combines familiar motivational concepts with a distinctive twist. It begins by reinforcing established schemas, highlighting the importance of patience and long-term effort for success, as exemplified by the phrase "a year's work does not need to be accomplished in a day." The message then further reinforces schemas by highlighting flexibility, suggesting that challenges, such as "crumbling tower moments," can reveal hidden strengths, including the ability to adapt; the most important approach for the horoscope, however, is disrupting schema because it goes against the commonly held beliefs regarding productivity and fight. For instance, the urging to "rest your swords" reverses the notion that to achieve something, one must be active and explains that resting can be productive. The strange

and funny imagery of levitating invites a fresh angle by proposing that people must change how they look at challenges and success. The horoscope message makes several stylistic devices, such as metaphors and imagery, to communicate the ideas of strength and change appropriately. Phrases like" crumbling tower moments" and "levitating", it employed metaphor to change the definition of struggle into an opportunity for growth. The symbolic description of "resting your swords" serves to contrast action and rest, which contests the assumption that success requires continual effort. It includes symbolic language, which combines contrast and destruction with discovery. This language depicts the strengths that lie within challenges. A playful tone with colloquial phrases like "whatever **your boat"** makes the advice approachable, **personification** of the swords proposes a reciprocal understanding between the reader and their fights. These devices together encourage a rethinking of failure and success. All these devices depict the concept of failure and success as the opposite of what is previously stated; they urge the reader to view challenges as opportunities for growth.

• Figure and Ground

From the Figure and Ground perspectives, the horoscope message primarily relies on newness as its dominant figure attractor, using fresh and unexpected metaphors like "crumbling tower moments" and "levitating, , whatever floats your boat "demonstrate the struggles of growth in a new way. Novel constructs and phrases such as these stand out against the backdrop of motivational discourse, which commonly features the themes of patience and endurance. Furthermore, the text establishes agency by appealing to readers to view themselves as active actors in their alteration by suggesting they "realise how good they are at parkour or even **levitating"** during trying times. Moreover, activity is highlighted through command sentences such as "rest your swords," depicting forceful action, which recommends that movement and action are associated with the struggle to achieve success. The topicality and fullness provide stability and anchor the text within familiar self-help notions, but the text amazingly focuses on the transportability of their imagery and metaphors. Flexibility and patience are key components that usually accompany motivational horoscopes discourse, marking its presence. However, the matchless inventions of the text reignite interesting and powerful notions that will forever change how we think about achievement.

2. Second level of analysis: Functional Stylistics

Aquarius horoscope prediction establishes key concepts, such as in the statement "Wanting to create something big but feeling unsure and doubtful, Aquarius?" where the focus is on internal conflict, guiding the reader toward

the central topic. The subsequent information, exemplified by "Well, it is only in your crumbling tower moments that you realise how good you are at parkour or even levitating", shifts the emphasis toward resilience and hidden potential. The Vocative case is exemplified by the engagement "Aquarius" and encourages personal engagement with the audience. This situation creates an effective link with the reader. Cohesion is maintained through the use of conjunctive devices, as seen in "Tap into that inner zen, rest your swords, a year's work doesn't have to be achieved in a day, and the first page doesn't have to reveal your entire story", where coordinating conjunctions seamlessly link related motivational ideas. Furthermore, reference cohesion is evident in the pronoun usage, which preserves clarity and engagement by consistently addressing the reader. These textual elements collectively create a cohesive and coherent message that guides the reader through a structured yet thought-provoking perspective on struggle and self-discovery.

12. Pisces Horoscope: January 1, 2025

"Time to go solo. Your dreams are meant for you to decode, your visions for you to create, your happiness for you to nurture, and your peace for you to feel. Pisces, walk away from drama or anything that pressurises you to play small, pushing you into a victim mindset. Your head aches not because your dreams are too big; you simply are sleepless because you are allowing yourself to be lined, hooked and sinkered(Sahgal, 2025).

1. First level of analysis

• Cognitive stylistics: Schema Theory

Most prominently, schema preservation can be identified in this horoscope, which does not clearly persist with the classical view of Pisces being passive and overly romantic. Instead, it reinforces schemas by admitting characteristics associated with Pisces, such as having a tendency to feel deeply and being sensitive in phrases like "**pressurises you to play small**" and "pushing you into a victim mindset." However, the most predominant strategy is disrupting schema because the horoscope challenges the expectation that Pisces is a weak or dreamy creature lacking concrete activity. In commanding independence, "walk away from drama," and "your dreams are meant for you to decode," the words encourage active engagement rather than passive submission, altering the dominant storyline of the horoscope towards enablement. For instance, rather than depicting Pisces as overly sensitive to pressure from external forces, the horoscope represents them as having the ability to take charge of their lives and challenge the notion that big dreams are the source of suffering.

• Figure and Ground

Pisces horoscope description contains multiple figures and ground

attractors, concerning newness is calling to embrace new ways of seeing things by moving away from old ways and "walk away from drama." At the same time, activeness is enhanced with the use of the imperative form "walk away," "decode," "create," and "nurture." The agency stands out as the most prominent attractor. The lines provided make a strong case for enablement and underline self-determination, such as "your dreams are meant for you to decode," alongside dismissing any imposed restrictions, "walk away from drama." This demand to responsibility strongly places a person as a decision-maker and agent of change, not as a receiver of circumstance surrendering to fate. Topicality is introduced when the extract highlights universal concerns about ambition, peace, and worth, rendering it relevant on a individual level. Moreover, definiteness and fullness come through with the impressive tone and completeness in ideas expressed, principally in "your happiness for you to nurture, and your peace for vou to feel," which summarizes finality and self-sufficiency. Agency, however, remains the focal point, as the horoscope guides the focus on the individual's determining of their life experiences instead of being subjected to external influences.

2. Second level of analysis: Functional Stylistics

Within the framework of functional stylistics, the text is arranged and interpreted through the textual metafunction: coherence and meaning in the Pisces horoscope are manifest in its themes, cohesion, conjunctive cohesion, and reference cohesion. The predominant theme, which serves as the basis for guiding interpretation, is personal and imperative. "Time to go solo," a quotation from the horoscope, signs the topical theme of individual activity. The following clauses further maintain this emphasis by repeated reference to "your dreams," "visions," and "happiness," reinforcing personal responsibility. Cohesion through lexical repetition is achieved as "your" is reiterated as a possessive pronoun, complemented by parallelism in possessive pronouns within "your dreams," "your visions," "your happiness," and "your peace." This increases unity and coherence. Conjunctive cohesion opposes causal and contrastive relationships: "not because your dreams are too big; you simply are sleepless because of" highpoints internal strength versus external pressure. Finally, cohesion through reference is retained with personal deixis as "Pisces" and "you" are used to focus attention and construct a direct relationship with the audience. The horoscope is structured across the self-empowerment discourse while maintaining coherence and flexibility, thus fulfilling the textual metafunction.

5. Discussion

The analysis reveals how the language of the horoscopes interacts with readers and engages them widely. To answer the two research questions, the functional cognitive stylistic approach deepens the understanding of language use in daily horoscopes by offering a framework that connects linguistic features with cognitive processes and reader engagement. This approach allows for the exploration of how specific language choices such as metaphors, imperatives, rhetorical questions, and direct address. All these engage readers on both a cognitive and emotional level. Horoscope scripts express, preserve, or challenge interpretations of schemas, while figureground dynamics highlight regard to main messages, such as agency and activeness. Regarding functional stylistics, the vocative function appears in several daily horoscopes, which makes horoscopes personalized texts. These stylistic techniques facilitate a deeper understanding of horoscope languages by demonstrating how linguistic structures support coherence and engagement. This is in concordance with previous studies that have the same findings, such as (Jaafar, 2014a; Jaafar, 2014b; Kučerová, 2023). Cognitive tools, particularly Schema Theory and Figure and Ground, shape the interpretation of themes in daily horoscopes by providing a cognitive structure that helps readers understand and internalise the messages within the text. Schema Theory allows for the identification of how horoscopes preserve or disrupt existing cognitive schemas those deeply ingrained beliefs about personality, relationships, or success that readers bring to the text. Ultimately, horoscopes are designed to motivate and influence impression and self-reflection rather than provide a direct prediction.

6. Conclusion

This study shows that using functional cognitive stylistics helps to understand how horoscopes engage readers and encourage personal growth. Horoscope predictions are presented with specific linguistic strategies to challenge beliefs and reinforce positive qualities, promoting self-reflection and empowerment. They highlight personal agency and enhance motivation, turning them into tools for personal development that go beyond just predicting the future. This study reveals the role of cognitive tools such as Schema Theory and Figure-Ground Theory in shaping readers' interpretations and identifying stylistic features within daily horoscope predictions. The language of horoscopes is commonly organized with specific syntactical and rhetorical characteristics to promote belief and participation. Finally, horoscope predictions often follow a linguistic pattern that matches overall statements with personalized instructions to attract a broad audience. This structure is purposeful, employing linguistic and rhetorical means to make the predictions appear personal while retaining enough flexibility to apply to a broad audience.
