"Analyzing Political Discourse focuses on analyzing its linguistic structure, performance, distribution, reception, influence, and responsiveness" (Hamood, 2019). Political discourse causes a large attendance, due to their influence on economic, cultural and societal (Abdulameer and Noor, 2019).

Abstract--- The purpose of this study was to describe and analyze winning speech by US President Biden on, November 7, 2020 in the presidential American elections, by the Appraisal System Analysis. The discourse analysis was applied by breaking down the discourse into several sentences and analyzing them to find out the Appraisal Devices and the types of Attitudes used. From the data Analyzing, it could be inferred that the speech employed three kinds of Attitudes; Affect, Judgment, Appreciation. These can be traced in

46 clauses which contained 20 for affects, 10 for judgments, and 16 for appreciations. The findings reveal that affect is most commonly used by Biden. On the other hand, he mostly used positive sentences within explicit attitude in The Washington post. On the other hand, he called to unity of America and rebuild the relations with world and promised America for better life and faced the COIVED 19 at the same time.

winning speech by president Biden's on November 7, 2020, considers to be anew style for political discourses that seem in the broadcasting in the present time to refer to provoke



international theory about plans and intentions of thenew government. Therefore, the political discourse need good audience to analyze it (Fairclough, 1995).

As one kind of appraisal resources, is attitude plays an important role in the expression of interpersonal meanings oflanguage. When you show how you feeltowards someone or her/his behave in aparticular situation we can call attitude. According to (Martin and White, 2001) "Attitude refers to values by which speakers pass judgment and associate emotional/affectual responses with participants and processes". Appraisal Framework (attitude) provides an analytical tool for us to evaluate Biden'svictory speech in The Washington postnewspaper.

II The framework: of Appraisal System (Attitude)

Analysis of the political speech of Biden's winning speech bases on Appraisal system. It's a part of the theoretical apparatus of Systemic Functional Linguistics (Halliday, 1985;Halliday & Matthiessen, 2014).

Martin & White, 2005, "state the Appraisal framework is referring with "how evaluation is established, amplified, targeted and sourced". The interpersonal dimension and is concerned with "the subjective presence of writers/speakers in texts is referring to appraisal system and they adopt stances towards both the material broad field of study involving politics, communication studies, sociology, psychology, cognitive science, anthropology, and others. Therefore, it can be say that analysis political discourse considers to be the understood, by any intellectual, political, economic or cultural subject through published in media. When the politicians have purpose to achieve or aspecific goal for an individual, or organization in which it includes economic, cultural and social implications. The context of the political discourse distinguishes to understand it and in which the discourse is delivered. It mostly refers ambiguity, inclusion and sometime show direct meanings indirect methods. Which helps to achieve communication with audience to influence them.

Throughout history in several countrieshave used many tools to market their program. One of the most importanttools and means are Political discourses. So, the parties deliver messages and ideas through the political discourse. Through their messages seek to achieve their objectives, and goals to obtain the support of the political elite for public policy and its directions (Aschale,2013). It considers most important toolsthat deals with texts, policies and political decisions related to regionaland international relations of the rulingpower of the state. It considers a sourceof ideological, intellectual and political approaches based on the content and objectives. It helps to formal authority resorts to legitimize its decisions and encourage its people to participate in general life (Aschale, 2013). They were analyzed using tool from SystemicFunctional Linguistics (SFL), Appraisal. Texts were downloaded andthen copied and pasted into a widely available word processing softwarepackage. They were then divided into clauses, and embedded clauses were identified. Then, the clauses were pasted into a widely available spreadsheet software package for appraisal analysis.



Attitude Analysis

A study applied procedure for the analysis of Attitude in *Washington post* newspapers. In identifying the attitude, the sentences were divided not into clauses but into sentences in the word processor and then transferred into separate spreadsheets (Washington). After identifying the attitude, the socialactor speech of the appraised (target) the results of the attitude analysis were put into a separate spreadsheet to be counted. This was done manually, tallied and placed in differentspreadsheets. The numbers of attitude of each sub-type, positive or negative, were put in specific columns.

IV FINDINGS AND DISCUSSIONS OF Biden winning speech IN the Washington post NEWS

Biden used all the types of the attitude systems in his speech as seen in Table 1below:

According to Martin & White, 2005,"the Appraisal theory consist of threemain domains: Attitude, Engagementand Graduation. Our concern in this study Attitude system it is concerned with positive and negative emotional reactions, feelings, and evaluation of things. Attitude divided into three types are Affect contains the resources for construing feelings and emotional reactions (like happiness/unhappiness, satisfaction/insatisfaction, security/insecurity).

The secondJudgement is related to resources to evaluate behaviour according to different normative principles (social,moral, etc.).

Finally, Appreciationincludes resources to capture aesthetic valuation. Attitude is often seen as the central system within Appraisal, the way in which we can express feelings and evaluation of both people andthings.

Methodology

Evaluation in our corpus is analyzedthrough the annotation of structures andwords presented in the discourse of theBiden. This analysis is fundamentally focused on adjectives (for Appraisal) which carry high positive/negative evaluative loads. In this section, we discuss the corpus collection methodology and the annotation of the relevant linguistic features.


