Publishing rules in Journal of Kirkuk's Arts (JKA)

1. The journal is dedicated to publishing research related to studies and humanities in both Arabic and English, in the following specializations: research and studies in (languages and their literature, historical and archaeological studies, applied geography, media, social and intellectual studies, religions, and Orientalism studies).
2. Research papers may be submitted in either Arabic or English.
3. Manuscripts must be printed on A4 paper, using Simplified Arabic font for Arabic texts and Times New Roman for English texts, and submitted on a CD along with two printed hard copies.
4. All information must be recorded on the journal's template, including the research title, author(s) names (first, second, etc.), academic degree, place of work, and full e-mail address.
5. The manuscript must include an abstract in both Arabic and English, not exceeding 100 words.
6. The research must include keywords relevant to the title and content of the study.
7. The paper must not have been previously published, submitted for a degree, or extracted from the intellectual property of another researcher. A written declaration by the author must be submitted upon delivery.
8. The researcher is required to adhere to sound scientific methodology.
9. The research paper should not exceed 25 pages. If exceeded, the author shall bear an additional cost for each extra page.
10. Submitted manuscripts will not be returned to the authors, regardless of whether they are accepted for publication or not.
11. Tables and figures must be numbered consecutively as they appear in the text, titled, and submitted on separate sheets. Diagrams must be drawn in black ink, and images must be of high resolution.
12. References must follow the American Psychological Association (APA) style, with in-text citations and endnotes included in parentheses and listed sequentially at the end of the manuscript.
13. Authors are responsible for correcting any linguistic or typographical errors in their work after peer review.
14. Publication fees are non-refundable in the event of rejection by the scientific reviewers. The journal operates under a self-funding system; therefore, authors must cover the full publication fees, which include publishing, formatting, and plagiarism checking, amounting to 150,000 IQD for local authors and \$125 USD for authors outside Iraq.
15. Upon request, the journal will provide the author with a copy of their published research.
