Rules for Research Publishing in Basra Research Journal:

1. The order of the first page should be as below:
 - a. The title is in the upper part of the page.
 - b. Under the title, it should be mentioned whether the research is a part of a thesis, a dissertation, a promotion research or any other type.
 - c. Below that, the full name(s) of the researcher(s), the university, the college and the department should be mentioned.
2. The Arabic Abstract for all departments except Department of English should not exceed five lines, and should be, along with the title of the research and the name(s) of the researcher(s), translated by the Service Unit in the Department of English. It should be stamped and brought with the research. In the researches that are written in English, the title, the name(s) of the researcher(s) and the Abstract should also be translated into Arabic.
3. The font of printing for Arabic language is (Simplified Arabic), whereas (Times New Roman) is used for English language. For printing, only (Word 2007) is to be used.
4. Font size (12) is used for the text, (14) for the titles and (10) for notes. Line spacing is (1.5 cm) and the page margins (2.5 cm) for all sides.
5. Numbering should be in the bottom of the page, avoiding any signs, frames or lines.
6. Notes and references are put at the end of the research.
7. Molded lines or signs, in particular Quran verses and the expressions (God's blessing and peace be upon him), (peace be upon him) and (May God be pleased with him) should be avoided.
8. The researcher submits 40.000 Iraqi dinars with four paper copies of the research for all departments except the Department of English and the Department of Arabic, which submit 30.000 Iraqi dinars.
9. After the research is evaluated and the result of the evaluation is (qualified to publishing), it is sent back to the researcher(s) who should do the suggested corrections. Acceptance of publication is given after the researcher presents a final corrected paper copy and an electronic one in the form of (Word) on a CD. The original copies on which corrections are made should be presented. The whole research is presented in a file.
10. Details of Fees.
 - a. For the MA and PhD students, 3.000 Iraqi dinars are paid for each of the first 25 pages. For pages over the first twenty-five, 4.000 Iraqi dinars are paid for each page.
 - b. For researches that are presented for promotion, 4.000 Iraqi dinars are paid for each of the first 25 pages, and 5.000 Iraqi dinars are paid for each page over the first twenty-five.
11. The journal commits to publish all the researches that are given publishing acceptance, and which fees are paid. The journal does not accept researches whose researches aim only at getting publishing acceptance without willingness to pay fees for publishing.
12. The journal cannot accept any research that does not conform to the above conditions.
